



CAREERS IN THE COMMON GOOD SCHOLARSHIP

Montana Campus Corps, in partnership with the Colorado Campus Compact UCAN Serve AmeriCorps program, provides up to \$5,000 annually to current *non-stipended* members for Careers in the Common Good (CCG) scholarships. The CCG Scholarships support professional and personal member development opportunities in the amount of up to \$250 per member. These opportunities may include professional conferences, site-specific trainings, personal development workshops, and topic-specific forums addressing critical community needs. For most members, the CCG Scholarship supports their first professional or member development experience, further solidifying their commitment to serving community needs through their specific field or interest area and connecting them to other professionals in the field.

To be eligible for the CCG Scholarship, members must meet the following criteria:

- A Non-stipended Campus Corps member
- An active member (not in “exited” status in the management database)
- Applying for a personal or professional development event that clearly connects to their direct service
- Submit the Campus Corps CCG Scholarship Application with details of the event and requested scholarship amount, not to exceed \$250 per member
- Each member is eligible for a total of one award

Once a request has been approved, CCG Scholarship funds will be disbursed to the sponsoring agency for registration fees and to the member as a reimbursement for lodging, travel, and meal expenses. Members must submit original receipts along with a Travel Reimbursement Form and Campus Corps Service Scholarship Report for reimbursements *within 30 days* of attending the event. Approved members will be provided with a Travel Reimbursement Form upon notification.

If the number of applications exceeds the number of scholarships available, we will review each application and fund those requests that most closely connect with the member’s Campus Corps term of service. Similarly, we may award partial scholarships to members. For example, if we receive 25 applications for the same event or program within one academic year, we may award all 25 members with partial awards of \$125 each, rather than the full \$250 per member.
