

GARDEN CITY TRIATHALON REFUND POLICY

The primary goals of the MTCC Garden City Triathlon are: 1) to produce a safe and fun community event for participants, volunteers, and spectators; and 2) to raise awareness and funds for the community work of the Montana Campus Compact. With those goals in mind and with regard to the work and preparation that it takes to produce a race, NO REFUNDS are available if a participant cancels or withdraws from the race.

We respect and recognize the aspirations and commitment of all racers. Unfortunately, there may be circumstances where it is deemed unsafe to proceed with the race as planned. Therefore, we reserve the right to cancel or alter the race to avoid exposing participants and the community to undue risks that might result from staging the event under potentially hazardous conditions. If we must cancel the race, AND ONLY IF WE MUST CANCEL the race, we will allow participants to roll their registration to the following year.

In the case of lightning, severe weather, fire or other condition that affects the potential safety of the participants, spectators, and volunteers, the event may be delayed. The event will start when it is safe to proceed. A delayed race is NOT considered a canceled race and the NO REFUND policy will apply.

Regardless of event day conditions, all participants should know and understand their own fitness level and readiness to participate. It is understood that each participant assumes personal responsibility upon entering the event and understands the inherent risk that triathlon (swimming, bicycling, and running) presents.
