- \$9,186.85 awarded for Member development through the Careers in the Common Good



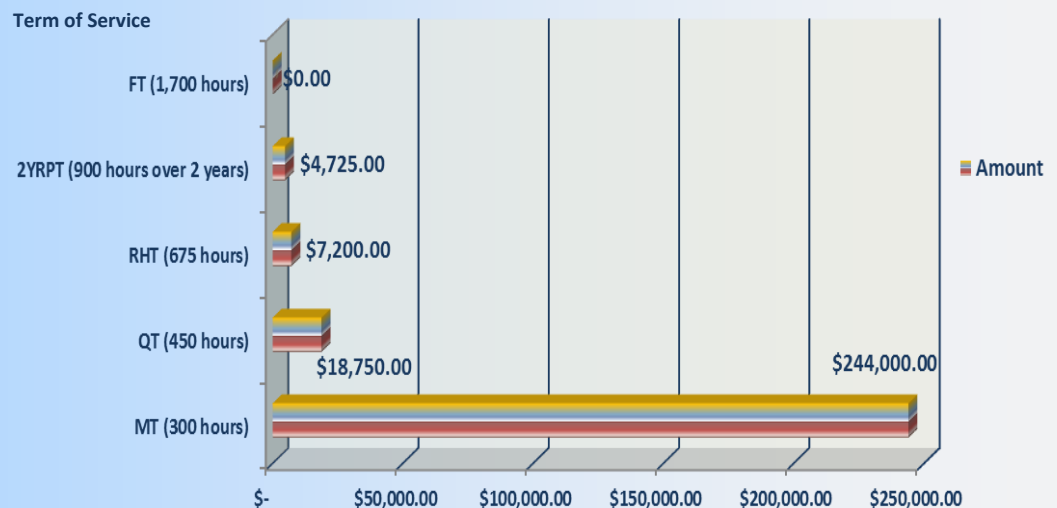
For the 2011 -2012 grant year, Compact Service Corps has enabled campuses throughout Arizona, Colorado, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota and South Dakota to provide 4,761 college and university students the opportunity to meet critical needs in their communities through service with local nonprofit and government agencies.

By aligning academic programs with identified community needs, Compact Service Corps Members serve in one of three primary focus areas:

- Education
 - Increasing academic engagement in K-12 students.
- Healthy Futures
 - Providing primary and preventive healthcare to those living in medically underserved areas.
- Capacity Building
 - Recruiting, training and managing volunteers for nonprofit and government agencies.

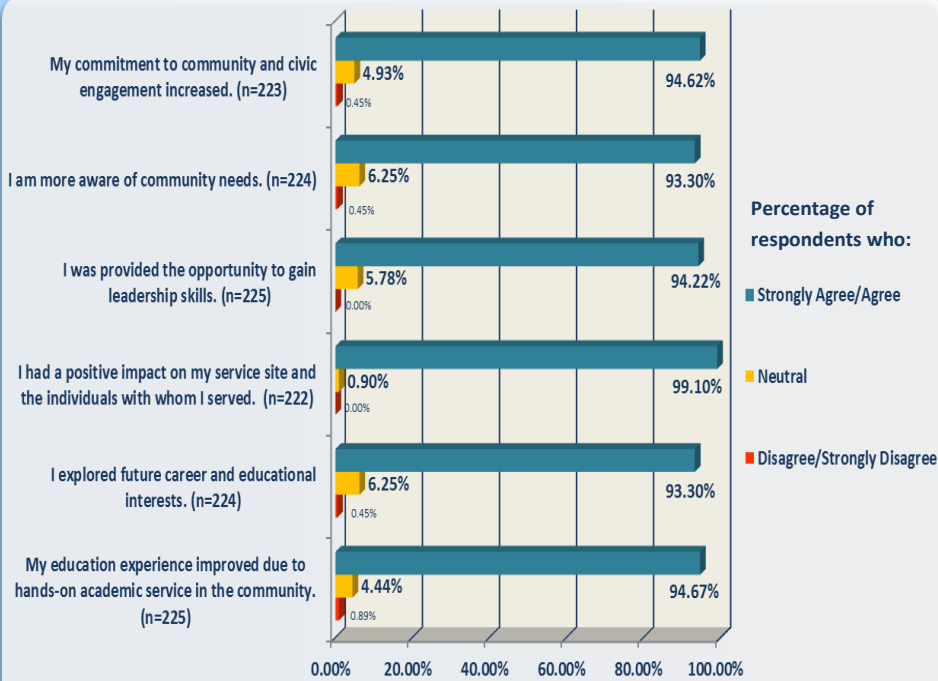

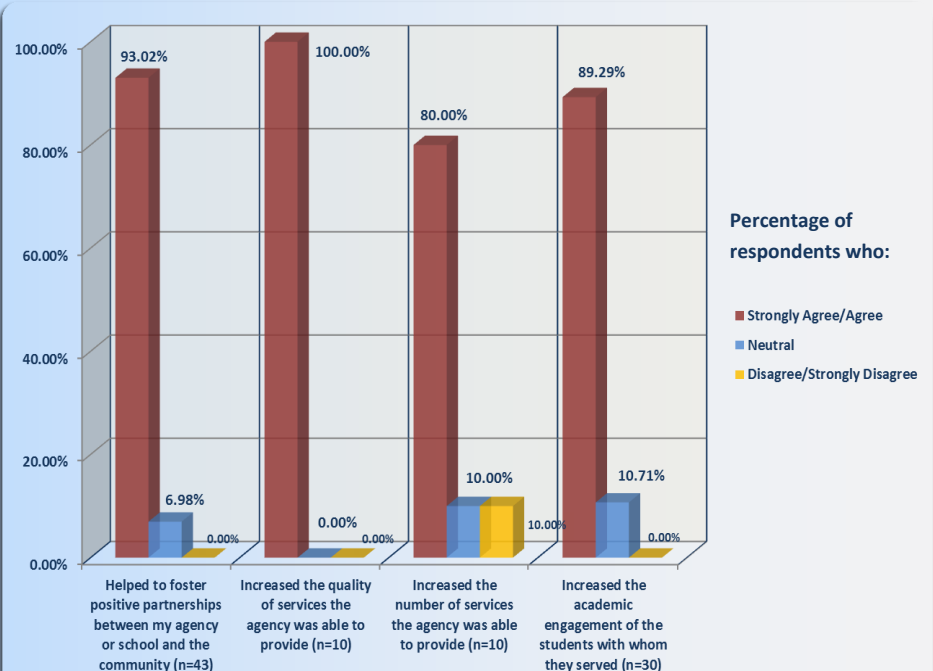

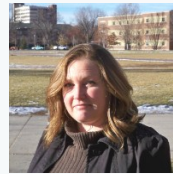
